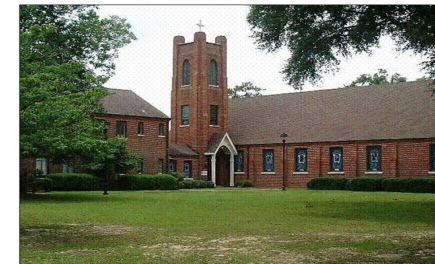

In the busyness of our world, it is so easy to be distracted by the little things of life. We can so easily be distracted by the things that are not important and will not have lasting significance. It is amazing how those little things can consume so much of our time and energy. Therefore, it is helpful for us to remind each other regularly about the truly important, the saving parts of life.

I am grateful to the theologian, Reinhold Niebuhr, for reminding me through the years of the saving elements of life. I have his words written on a slip of paper so that when I feel most distracted by the little things of life, I read:

“Nothing worth doing is completed in our lifetime; therefore, we must be saved by **HOPE**. Nothing true, beautiful, or good makes complete sense in any immediate context of history; therefore, we must be saved by **FAITH**. Nothing we do, however virtuous, can be accomplished alone; therefore, we are saved by **LOVE**. No virtuous act is quite as virtuous from the standpoint of our friend or foe as from our stand-point. Therefore, we must be saved by the final form of love, which is **FORGIVENESS!**

This church has not been distracted. Instead, we have reached beyond our walls to help our brothers and sisters. Though we are still dealing with the pandemic, and many have had setbacks and so many issues with families and work, we still keep our eyes focused on our brothers and sisters in Christ.
