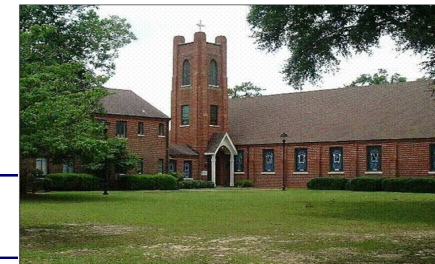

I offered a Zoom Bible Study during the month of August. We studied how stress affected your heart, soul, strength, and mind in relationship to God. As we talked about stress I wanted to share with you all the “10 Commandments” on dealing with Stress:

- 1) You shall learn to say No!
- 2) You shall learn that everything does not have to be done today!
- 3) You do not have to fight over everything!
- 4) You do not have to be loved by everyone!
- 5) You do not have to be responsible for everyone's actions! (children's, spouses, etc.)
- 6) You do not have to be right about everything!
- 7) You do not have to do certain things to be loved!
- 8) You do not have to be “perfect” in everything you do!
- 9) You do not have to know everything!
- 10) You do not have to go “full throttle” all the time! You can slow down!

As we talked each week, I used several scripture verses (Matt. 6:25-34, I Peter 5:7, Matt. 8:26, Luke 10:27) to name a few, and we shared our thoughts and hearts with each other.

I pray each of you will spend time each day with God in prayer and listen to Him as you just soak up His love and peace. Listen as His still small voice warms your heart or His booming, echoing voice love rattles your bones. Either way, may your faith ensure you not to worry about all that is happening in this world... He has got this, and He has got you. Focus on Him and how you can be in relationship with Him; Heart, Soul, Mind and Strength and do not worry about the rest.

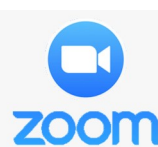
